Designing a PCMH Development Plan

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Suggested Steps...

- Convene PCMH development TEAM
- 2. Schedule regular PCMH development TEAM meetings
- 3. Determine goals for PCMH development
- Complete a Readiness Assessment and identify gaps in PCMH core capabilities
- 5. Action Planning Identify a Pathway to PCMH Implementation
- Develop a workplan and timeline to accomplish your goals, including responsibilities for TEAM members
- 7. Engage your entire clinic team, Re-assess status regularly, Celebrate successes!

1. Convene PCMH Development TEAM

Convene a PCMH Team that includes a designated Coordinator or Manager as well as staff who:

- Interact with patients in some fashion
- Influence policy, process, or practice
- Are knowledgeable about data and how it can be extracted
- Are committed to PCMH development
- Are committed to learning and sharing knowledge
- Are committed to rolling up their sleeves and getting it done

2. Schedule regular PCMH development meetings with **TEAM**

Ten steps for effective team meetings

- Identify the team
- Meet regularly and "on-the-clock"
- Agree on ground rules
- Set a consistent meeting agenda
- Rotate meeting roles

- Solve problems as a group
- Record action steps, owners and due dates
- Practice good meeting skills
- Have some fun!
- Celebrate your successes

3. Determine Goals for PCMH 2017 Transition

- On our last webinar we presented options for each organization, depending on their size and status with PCMH recognition
 - Case Study A: Organizations with all sites recognized (one or more sites) at 2014 PCMH Level 3
 - Case Study B: Submitted a <u>Multi-Site</u> application for 2014 guidelines, now want to get new sites recognized
 - Case Study C: Submitted 1 or more <u>individual</u> site applications, now want to get new sites recognized
 - Case Study D: One or more sites with 2014 Level 3 & one or more sites with 2014 Level 2

3. Determine Goals for PCMH 2017 Transition (continued)

- Your PCMH workplan (the focus of this webinar) will depend on your organization's goals
 - For example, if your practice site already has PCMH 2014 Level 3 recognition, you will be focusing your workplan just on the CORE 2017 criteria
 - For example, if your practice site is pursuing new recognition, you will focus on all 2017 criteria
- Make sure to consult the slides from "Webinar 07.10.18 How to <u>Transition to and Maintain 2017 PCMH Recognition – Case</u>
 <u>Studies and Resources</u>." where we mention how you may be able to shorten the documentation workload based on your organization's status with PCMH recognition

4. Complete a Readiness Assessment

- Use the <u>CHS PCMH</u>
 <u>Tracker 2017</u> to do a self-assessment of the core criteria.

5. Action Planning based on Readiness Assessment

Identify a Pathway for PCMH Development

- Which criteria are already "in place" but need to have a policy/evidence of implementation? Note: through this exploration and development you may find that you make a few tweaks to your processes that's typical!
- Do you have sufficient criteria and credits already identified?
- Are there additional criteria you may need to implement in order to achieve recognition?
- The list of criteria you have or plan to implement is your pathway/roadmap

Pathway to PCMH Recognition

- We developed a version of the CHS PCMH Tracker where we highlighted a set of elective criteria that could get you to PCMH recognition
 - This is a jump start not a prescription
 - This is meant for organizations new to PCMH recognition
 - Downloadable from <u>Jump Start Pathway to PCMH Recognition</u>
- We also created an accompanying tool a <u>Core Criteria</u> <u>Implementation Priorities Pathway</u>.
 - One approach for choosing implementation priorities/order of operations

The CHS PCMH Tracker_Pathway

 We evaluated all 100 criteria and considered which criteria may be the most feasible for safety net organizations.

We realize that decisions about these criteria are best left to each organization. Please consider this Pathway as just one approach, from which your organization may further tailor the criteria you wish to put in place for PCMH recognition.

Core Criteria Implementation Priorities Pathway

- We put together a list of core criteria, in order of priority for implementation (what to work on first, second...)
- This is one approach, we encourage you to adjust based on your organizational capacity and capabilities determined in the self-assessment

How to use it:

- 1. New recognition: Systematically study each criterion, engage team members, develop capacity, and prepare evidence of implementation
- 2. Existing recognition: Preparing for annual check-in or accelerated renewal by reviewing core criteria to ensure processes are still in place

A Pathway for Implementation of Core Criteria NCQA PCMH 2017 Guidelines

Indee are all corresponded mental in the NOVA PCNIM 2017 Standards and Guidelines, Based on our knowledge of implementation considerations for these citieria, we recommend a pathway and priority list below. This is not meant to be prescriptive but is one approach for practices to use as they work through implementation and transformation.


