## A message from Virginia Community Healthcare Association CEO, Tracy Douglas

---

On behalf of Virginia's Community Health Centers (CHCs), which Virginia Community Healthcare Association (VCHA) represents, I extend our greetings and best wishes for a successful 2026 legislative session.

Last year brought unprecedented challenges for Virginia's CHCs. Federal funding delays, workforce shortages, and looming changes to Medicaid and insurance programs placed vulnerable communities at risk. The implementation of federal legislation (HR1) will further impact access to Medicaid coverage, increase uncertainty around health insurance tax credits, and limit loan programs for medical and dental students—creating devastating financial consequences and challenges to workforce access. Meanwhile, CHC reimbursement rates still fail to cover the true cost of care. These pressures threaten the stability of health centers that provide essential primary care, behavioral health, dental, and preventive services to more than 422,000 Virginians annually.

CHCs are serving more patients than ever yet funding has not kept pace with demand. Patient volumes have grown 16.7% since 2020, while federal support has declined, leaving many CHCs operating at a loss. Without additional resources, CHCs may be forced to cut services just as the number of uninsured Virginians is projected to rise under HR1. We urge you to increase support to ensure these vital health centers can continue serving families and communities who rely on them.

Sustained, predictable funding, protection of Medicaid and insurance support, and investment in the CHC workforce are critical to maintaining access to care and the health of communities across the Commonwealth.

I look forward to working with you to prioritize the health of Virginians in 2026.

## What is a Community Health Center?

---

Community Health Centers, also known as Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), operate under the regulation of the U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration's Bureau of Primary Care. Their core funding is provided through Section 330 of the United States Public Health Service Act.

In exchange for their designation as FQHCs, Community Health Centers are required, by law, to:

- Turn no patient away regardless of ability to pay
- Charge for services based on sliding fee scales
- Operate under a Board of Directors comprised of more than 50% patients
- Be accountable to the Bureau of Primary Care to ensure quality care and regulatory compliance
- Offer enabling services to assist patients with barriers to care, including:
  - Transportation
  - Language translation
  - Food security
  - Accessing other social services such as Medicaid coverage

In the Commonwealth of Virginia, community health centers are in urban, rural, mountain and coastal communities. They are as operationally diverse as their topography and populations. Some are new, modern spaces and others need updating, making it important that they continue to receive funding that matches the needs of the patients they serve. Collectively, they provide a wide range of services, including:

- Behavioral Health
- Black Lung Disease Treatment
- Dentistry
- Family Medicine
- Internal Medicine
- Medication-assisted Treatment for Substance Use Disorder
- Men's Health
- Pediatrics
- Pharmacy
- Prenatal Care
- Urgent Care
- Women's Health



# Community Health Centers provide comprehensive care

---

"Susie," 69 years old, has been a patient of a Virginia Community Health Center for 25 years. She is known in her neighborhood as the candy lady. She shops for her 94-year-old neighbor's groceries. She is now retired, following a second career as a Certified Nursing Assistant.

She has six children and 25 grandchildren.

Susie chose the health center because it was in her community, close to where she lived. She stayed there because the doctors were good and the staff was friendly.

Ten years ago Susie became very ill, and was diagnosed with a serious chronic illness. This left her angry and depressed. One day, one of the community health center staff noticed her emotional difficulties and brought her into his office to talk. She said it was that moment of kindness that restored her will to live.

While Susie receives care for her chronic illness from a specialist, she receives all of her other care from the health center. She sings the praises of her doctors and case manager, who makes sure she has everything she needs to access her specialty care or wraparound services she needs, including the dental care she also receives from her community health center.

# In rural Virginia, Community Health Centers can be the only medical offices for miles

---

“Jack” has lived in rural Virginia his whole life, and has been a patient of the local Community Health Center since he was a child.

Jack’s family was always insured, and as a finance and accounting professional who has always had a good job, he is insured as an adult. Still, he gets his medical care from a community health center.

Why? They are where he lives. They are his doctors. They are caring doctors. They give him quality care that at times identified problems that other physicians missed.

Although there are scant medical practices within miles of Jack’s home and office, if there were one right around the corner, he would still go to his community health center.



# Community Health Centers help people suffering with substance use disorders return to happy, productive lives

---

Community Health Centers help people suffering with substance use disorders return to happy, productive lives.

“Alex” is 6' 4" tall, was a high school basketball star, and went to college.

Alex, a natural salesman, had a good job with benefits. Until the opioid dependence he had suffered for the better part of 20 years could no longer be hidden.

Three years ago, Alex had a psychiatric episode and called his mother from the side of the road.

Alex’s retired mother paid for his first detox, and connected him with his local community health center that helped him get Medicaid and an in-house substance abuse counselor. It was then that he began receiving medication-assisted treatment for his substance use disorder.

The health center found a treatment facility for Andrew, and transportation to get there.

Alex and his mother credit the health center counselor with saving Alex’s life and his mother’s sanity. Knowing that addiction is a family disease, the counselor helped mom learn to create healthy boundaries, and helped her understand the disorder. The counselor also helped Alex dig into the source of his struggles, and how to work hard to remain clean.

Alex has been clean for 18 months.

He now has a job he loves, lives his life with gratitude and helps others find treatment, get there, and leads NA meetings. He truly believes that by paying forward the help he received from the health center is keeping him clean and allowing him to have a greater impact.

# Medication assistance programs save lives

---

"Diane" is a 59-year-old single woman living alone on Social Security disability income. She has several serious conditions including COPD, high blood pressure, obstructive sleep apnea, diabetes, and hypothyroidism. Through the community health center, she receives ongoing care management, and requires numerous prescription medicines to treat her conditions. She is a Medicare patient, but unable to afford the Medicare Part-D premium to cover the costs of her medications.

Her total income on disability is \$14,580 a year. The retail cost of her medications is \$8,380 for a 90-day supply.

Fortunately, through the 340B pharmaceutical discount program she is able to get prescription drug assistance through her community health center. Diane readily acknowledges that the medication assistance program is the only way she could afford the medications that are keeping her alive and helping her to thrive.



Shenandoah Community Health (SCH) offers access to primary care, behavioral health, women's health, and oral healthcare in the Shenandoah Valley of West Virginia and Virginia. Since 1976, its dedicated clinicians, nurses, and support staff have worked to ensure that patients receive the highest quality, most comprehensive healthcare possible. SCH's wide range of coordinated healthcare services includes routine care as well as chronic disease treatment and management; mental health and substance use treatment; specialized care for women including prenatal care and delivery, gynecology and surgery; and comprehensive dental care for children and adults. As a medical home, SCH also offers WIC Nutrition Programs; HIV case management; weight and wellness program; on-site pharmacy; lab and x-ray services; nursing outreach to migrant and seasonal farmworkers and the homeless; medication assistance; assistance with health insurance enrollment; social work services; and family support resources. 


## Healthy Community Health Center




## Highland Medical Center


## Bland County Medical Clinic, Inc


Initially funded through a 5 year, \$4.5 million grant from the Harvest Foundation, Connect Health + Wellness began operations in April 2005.
